

Dear Parents/Carers,



In Reception, Year 1 and 2, your child will be coming home with two reading books.

The first and our main scheme of books are **Read Write Inc Phonics books** - these books match the learning they have done in school and contain the sounds they can sound-blend (green words) and have few exception words (red words). Re-reading these books will also help to build up fluency.

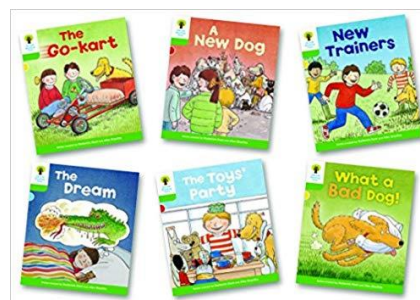
Read Write Inc Phonics Book Bag Book: For your child to read to you:	
	<p>The Red Ditty Books offer children practice in reading short decodable passages that form an important bridge between reading single words and whole sentences.</p> <p>They reinforce the Read Write Inc. Phonics Set 1 sounds.</p> <p>Each book contains three fun and humorous passages with linked reading activities. They also prepare children for reading the Storybooks.</p>
	<p>The Storybooks (Green to Grey Levels) are carefully matched to children's growing phonic knowledge so children can read them with accuracy, fluency and comprehension.</p> <p>The Storybooks include a range of engaging stories such as fairy tales, myths and legends, rhyming stories and familiar settings. Activities at the start help children to practise the sounds and words they will encounter in the story.</p> <p>Questions to talk about at the end of the story provide an extra opportunity for developing children's comprehension.</p>

In addition to this, **The Oxford Reading Tree scheme books** are then taken home as books **you can read to your child** to enjoy for pleasure.
